Jeremiah 5:24 AMP, “They do not say in their heart, “Let us now fear *and* worship the Lord our God [with profound awe and reverence], Who gives rain in its season, Both the **AUTUMN** and the spring rain, Who keeps for us the appointed weeks of the **HARVEST**.”

What is our attitude when we come into God’s presence? In the context of this scripture, the Lord is warning His people because they refuse to honor and respect who He is and what He’s done for them!!! God sets boundaries of the roaring ocean and sends the rain, assuring us of plentiful **HARVESTS**. God had to strip away all the benefits that Judah and Israel had grown to expect from Him and give the people another opportunity to turn back to Him. God, still on occasion, uses the same method of blessing or withholding blessings to get our attention. We must NOT wait until God removes our cherished resources before committing ourselves to Him as we should.



In the natural, September 22nd, ushers in the **AUTUMN / FALL** season, which means shorter days and longer nights. And according to the Almanac, we should be seeing the **HARVEST MOON** on September 10th.

The **AUTUMN / FALL** season also represents adulthood - a time of transformations: personal, environmental and spiritual. For instance: the coming of the **FALL** foliage in certain areas of our country where the leaves start changing colors and fall off the trees; the weather changes, it starts getting a little cooler; and certain foods come into season like, apple, pumpkin, and spice.

In regards to our **spiritual transformations**, with September being the ninth month of the year, it is a birthing season!!! All year, we’ve had so much travailing (painful or laborious effort) in the spirit, that **the birthing season has come forth!!!**

We give our **LORD GOD ALMIGHTY, THE LORD OF THE HARVEST**, all the glory, honor and praise for our **HARVEST SEASON**, as we reap the seeds that have been sown this year:

- ◆ Seeds of continued spiritual growth and maturity (Col 1:9-10)
- ◆ Seeds of healing (spiritually, physically, emotionally) (Isaiah 53:4-5; Jer 30:17; 1 Peter 2:24)
- ◆ Seeds of building up and edifying those who are broken (Eph 4:29)
- ◆ Seeds of laughter, we’ve been doing enough crying at night but our joy comes in the morning (Psalm 30:5)
- ◆ Seeds of dancing as King David danced to the Lord when he brought back the arc of the covenant (2 Samuel 6:14-22)
- ◆ Seeds that reproduce after their own - as we plant seeds for a building (Gen 1:11)
- ◆ Seeds of embracing one another, as the family of Christ (1 Cor 12:12-27)
- ◆ Seeds of seeking the lost sheep and bringing them to Christ (1 Tim 4:15 and 2 Peter 3:18)
- ◆ Seeds of sewing together our garments of praise (Isaiah 61:3)
- ◆ Seeds of speaking about Jesus - spreading His gospel (Matt 28:16-20)
- ◆ Seeds of loving as Jesus loves with that agape love that only He gives (John 13:34-35)
- ◆ Seeds of the Lord’s peace that surpasses all understanding (Phil 4:6-7)
- ◆ Seeds of living in abundance as we trust Him with our tithes & offerings (Malachi 3:10-12; Luke 6:38)



Heavenly Father, our One and only true living **LORD GOD ALMIGHTY**, our **LORD OF THE HARVEST**, who brings the **AUTUMN** rains, we glorify, honor and praise Your Holy Name!!! ## Rosh Hashanah / Jewish New Year of 5783

Our Jewish brothers and sisters will be celebrating **Rosh Hashanah, aka, The Feast of Trumpets, The Head of the Year, and The Jewish New Year of 5783**. This begins at sundown on September 25th through nightfall of September 27th for 2022.

**Rosh Hashanah** celebrates the anniversary of the creation of humanity. The symbols are apples, honey, shofars, pomegranates & Torah (the Word).

- ◆ Apples represent the fruitfulness of the coming year. Eating an apple dipped in honey symbolizes the desire for a sweet year.
- ◆ Honey is used to dip bread (challah) and is a reminder of the hope of a sweet new year
- ◆ Shofars are used to announce God's (Adonai's) presence and joy for the coming year
- ◆ Pomegranates have 613 seeds which corresponds to the 613 commandments in the Torah. Customarily, the seeds are consumed to represent that we now are equipped to walk in the commandments of the Lord by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- ◆ Torah is read during the celebrations and blessings are recited to each other. One of the blessings read is, "May you be inscribed and sealed for a good year."



**The Feast of Trumpets** is the sounding of the shofar as an awakening call to repentance and remembrance of who Adonai is; that He is good; that His mercies are new every morning; and that Jesus' Blood was shed for us so we should have new hope in a new year!!!

**The Head of the Year** signifies that wherever our focus is, that is the direction we will be led. When our head, and year, are focused on the Lord, we will align our time and resources with His will. It's like putting on the yoke of Adonai. The yoke turns the head and directs where our feet will go and what we will see. Adonai's yoke is the only one that's without burden and points us in a direction that will bless us and others.

**The Jewish New Year of 5783** is represented by the Hebrew letter Gimel (or Gimmel) for the number 3. The letter Gimmel resembles both a foot and a person walking in the direction of the left. The word Gimel is derived from the root Hebrew word *gemul*, which means "justified repayment," or the giving of reward and punishment.



- ◆ The number 5 represents - grace, favor, redemption
- ◆ The number 7 represents - completeness, wholeness, spiritual perfection
- ◆ The number 8 represents - new birth, new beginnings
- ◆ The number 3 represents - Holy Trinity, perfect witness & testimony, life

We are coming to the end of **5782**, which is also known as a Shmita year, a Sabbath year of rest for the people and the land. Every seven years, Adonai ordains a time of rest, forgiveness of debts and the release of slaves from bondage. Through wholehearted faith, trust and obedience in Adonai's Word, supernatural provisions were released such as miracles, signs and wonders on behalf of Adonai's faithful believers.

The beginning of the **Jewish New Year of 5783** will be a continuation and pinnacle point of the year **5782**. We pray for a sweet year accompanied by the Lord's presence; to be equipped to walk in Holy Spirit power; to be inscribed and sealed for a good year; to be justified by our faith; to be rewarded and blessed for our obedience to Adonai's Word; for Adonai's great grace; for favor with Adonai and with man; to bring redemption to the lost; to be complete and whole with spiritual perfection; for new births and new beginnings in every aspect of our lives; and to become perfect witnesses and testify of Holy Spirit's work in our lives, in Yeshua's Name we pray 🙏❤️
