PENTECOST / FESTIVAL OF WEEKS (SHAVOUT) & FIRST FRUITS

We will be celebrating **Pentecost Sunday**, on June 5th this year according to the Gregorian calendar. **Pentecost** is also known as **The Festival of Weeks (Shavout)** or **The Festival of First Fruits**. Our Jewish brothers & sisters always celebrate **Shavout** on the 6th of Sivan, according to the Jewish calendar. **Shavout** is a day of celebration and remembrance of God's instruction given to Moses at Mount Sinai. We read in Exodus 19:10-11, "Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their clothes. And let them be ready for the third day. For on the third day the Lord will come down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.'"



Jesus' ascension, as a type of **FirstFruit** from the dead (Revelation 1:5), occurred on the day God told the Israelites they were to wave a sheaf composed of the **FirstFruits** of their harvest (Leviticus 23:9 - 11). It was on this special Holy Day, the **Day of Pentecost**, that God first poured out his Holy Spirit upon the 120 believers who had gathered to keep the day.

Pentecost in Greek means 50, which represents the 50 days after Passover, signifying the celebration and remembrance of God's instruction. However, instead of the instruction coming down from Mount Sinai, The Lord deposited His Holy Spirit who leads us into all truth—into those who followed Christ then and continue to follow Him now.



It's on **Pentecost**, when the church was born. The outpouring of Holy Spirit came upon 120 Believers. We read in Acts 2:1-4, "When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance."

It was on **Pentecost** that Peter first preached the Gospel of Jesus Christ and brought 3,000 new Believers to Christ and baptized them in the Name of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:14-41). We have taken that commission to heart as we baptize on **Pentecost** every year.



Just as the Jews went to the Temple and offered **FirstFruits** and thanked God for what He had done and what He would do, we can do the same. The same Fire of the Holy Spirit that burned the Ten Commandments into the tablets of stone has written His law into our hearts and minds. There is a call to renew it as we became the **FirstFruits** of God's spiritual harvest of humans at **Pentecost!!!**

Heavenly Father, as we celebrate **Pentecost/Shavout**, we praise our Lord & Savior, Jesus Christ, for His ascension into Heaven as the **Firstfruits** of Your resurrection, Lord God. May we become **Firstfruits** of Your spiritual harvest so that we may be the laborers sent by You, the Lord of the Harvest, to bring others into the knowledge of Christ for the building of Your Heavenly Kingdom. Father God, may we open our hearts to be filled to overflowing with Your Holy Spirit to unleash Kingdom authority every where we go. Holy Spirit, pour Your fresh fire & Holy Boldness into Your Church, the Body of Christ. In Jesus' Holy Name we pray 🙏❤️✝️
