### SYMBOLS OF CHRISTMAS

It's the most wonderful time of the year!!! And why not??? We're celebrating the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!!! We know in our hearts that **JESUS IS**THE REASON FOR THE SEASON!! With that in mind, let's take a look at what some of the Christmas season's symbols represent spiritually.



The *Christmas Tree*, an *evergreen* which thrives in the dead of winter. It reminds us of the hope that we have in Jesus that will never fail in great trials and winters of our lives. It's been said that Martin Luther was one of the first to place lights or candles on a tree, representing the Light of Christ. (<a href="https://www.history.com/topics/christmas/history-of-christmas-trees">history-of-christmas-trees</a>). Let's choose to see the *evergreen Christmas tree* as a symbol of our hope for eternal life in Heaven through our Heavenly Father's gift of His Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. (John 3:16)

The *Star* which sometimes can be found sitting on top of a Christmas tree, is one of the most recognizable symbols of the holiday. The *Star* was highlighted in the sky when Jesus Christ was born and it led the Wise Men to Jesus. It reminds us to follow the *Light* of the Savior just as the Wise Men followed the light of the *Star* to find Him. (Matthew 2:2 & John 8:12)





The *Candy Cane* reminds us of the staffs that the shepherds' carry. The staffs are used as guiding instruments leading the sheep to food and water. They also protect the sheep from harm. *Jesus is our Great Shepherd* who laid down His life for His sheep and guides, protects, and provides daily. His sheep know Him and hear His voice. (John 10:11-14)

The *Holly*, because of its **red berries** and **prickly green leaves** which last all year round, is used as Christmas decoration all over the world. The sharp edges of the **holly leaf** remind us of the crown of thorns placed on the Savior's head. The **red holly berry** reminds us of Jesus' blood shed for each one of us. In some Scandinavian languages, the word for **holly** is "Christ-thorn." (Matthew 27:29; Mark 15:17 and John 19:2)



Christmas is the season of *Giving*. The Wise Men who came to see Jesus, presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. (Matthew 2:11). But the greatest gift of all came from our Heavenly Father,



"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16). As we open our brightly wrapped presents this year, let's remember that JESUS CHRIST, OUR LORD AND SAVIOR IS THE TRUE GIFT OF CHRISTMAS WHO KEEPS ON GIVING FOR ALL ETERNITY!!!
